



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

between
IMEKO and EUROLAB

This Memorandum of Understanding (the Memorandum) is made on 02. December 2021 between IMEKO, the International Measurement Confederation was founded in November 28, 1958 in Budapest, Hungary (address of IMEKO Secretariat: Dalszínház utca 10, HU-1061 Budapest, Hungary) and EUROLAB, the European Federation of National Associations of Measurement, Testing and Analytical Laboratories was created in Brussels, Belgium on April 27, 1990 (address of EUROLAB Secretariat: Rue du Commerce 20-22, BE-1000 Brussels, Belgium) for the purpose of achieving mutual aims and objectives relating to a joint cooperation in their fields of the metrology as detailed:

IMEKO and EUROLAB have agreed that

1. IMEKO and EUROLAB will inform each other of their activities and share the latest international scientific and technical news.
2. IMEKO and EUROLAB will be invited to take part in each other's General Assembly in an *observer capacity*.
3. IMEKO and EUROLAB will nominate liaison officers to ensure regular consultation.
4. IMEKO and EUROLAB will ensure adequate information about their activities and events through their publications (Acta IMEKO and seasonal e-Newsletters).
5. IMEKO and EUROLAB will encourage their members to participate in appropriate technical committees and events.
6. IMEKO and EUROLAB will coordinate the content and programming of conferences, symposia, workshops etc. where appropriate.
7. IMEKO and EUROLAB will promote through their strategy the development of the relationship between metrology, testing and industry.
8. IMEKO and EUROLAB will be engaged in the research and the application of the science and technology measurement.
9. IMEKO and EUROLAB will contribute to the enhancement of international co-operation among scientists and experts from both communities.

This Memorandum of Understanding is prolonged for a period of three years, after which the parties will decide on its prolongation, amendment or termination.
